

Storage Fee Change

Effective January 1, 2021 storage fees will be \$32.50/month or \$390/year for campers. Storage for golf carts with electricity will be \$15/ month with non-electric golf cart being \$10/ month. Utility storage is set at \$15/month. The change removes a cost break for an annual contract. No refunds will be given on annual contracts if cancelled prior to final month of storage.
